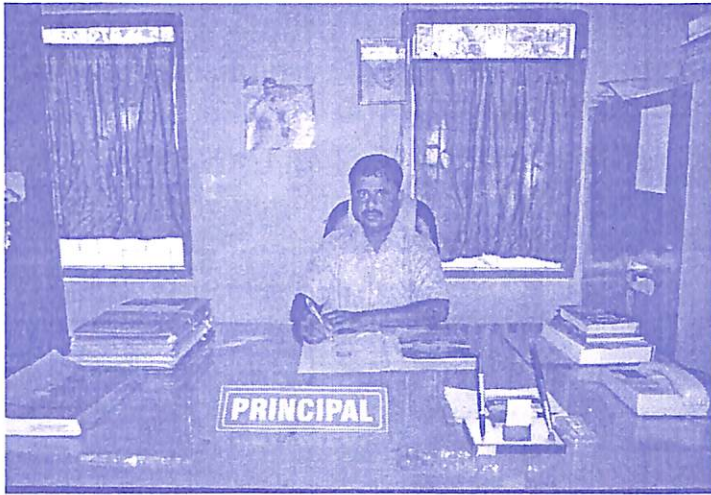

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## Principal's Column

Ramdia is situated in the north bank of the river Brahmaputra which is only 30 K.M. away from Guwahati. Really speaking, Ramdia is an admixture of many revenue villages viz - Majorkuri, Ujankuri, Sarubakra, Barbakra, Gandheletari, Bhelkar etc. The name of Ramdia is available in the history of Assam, specially in the history of the Ahoms. Ramdia may be said as a compound word. 'Ram' means big e.g. - Ram chagali, Ramchar, Ramtangan etc. and 'dia' means char/chapori, an island or bank formed by a river. The neighbouring villages of Ramdia like Tokradia, Hahdia, Khetrihardia, Borhardia bear this notion.

The famous pancha-tirtha of Hajo is situated in the east of Ramdia. The river Brahmaputra flowed to the south of Hajo and that very char (under Hajo) is called as 'Namdia' and gradually that very 'Namdia' may be transformed into Ramdia. In 'Kathaguru Charit', it is said "Tehe Hajor nama Ramdia balate choi Grihoke roise" (Page 570)

Ramdia is rich in the domain of education and culture in which Raibahadur Kaliram Medhi contributed a lot in the fermament of literature.

## A brief history of B.C.M. College, Ramdia:

Binandi Ch. Medhi College, Ramdia (formerly known as Ramdia College) situated at Ramdia, an institution for higher education was established on August 13, 1992.

A group of dedicated persons covering the greater area of Ramdia, Bangalpara, Tokradia, Khetrihardia, Barhardia, Sobancha, Dampur etc. with their relentless and untiring effort has established this institution to provide quality higher education. Later on, the college was renamed as Binandi Chandra Medhi College, Ramdia in the name of the donor's Dr. Jyoti Prasad Medhi's father as a gesture of gratitude.

Originally, the college started in “Ramdia Puthibharal Aru Samuhik Sanskritik Kendra” from 13/08/92 and then the college shifted to its present location of Binandi Chandra Medhi College, Ramdia.

The College attained opening permission on 14/08/1993 and temporary affiliated to GU in 1995-96. The college also obtained permission for concurrence on 29-12-1999 and obtained the Govt. concurrence up to part II level on 27-09-2004 and provincialised in 2013, according to the Assam Govt’s Venture Institution Provincialisation Act 2011. The college got permanent affiliation from G.U. on 18/12/09 and registered under society Act XXI of 1860 on 12/03/2012. The College is included under 2 (f) and 12 (B) of UGC Act. 1956.

Till today the college gets financial support from No. 1 Ramdia Samabai Samiti, Public donation, Theatrical performance, lottery and the financial assistance received from the Govt of Assam.

### ■ College Emblem :

The emblem of the college contains “या विद्या विमुक्तये” that implies “knowledge makes people free”. The emblem contains a book with a sharai”.



## ■ Location of the College :

The college is located in the western part of Sri Sri Haygriha Madhab Dewalaya, and Poa Mecca, Hajo. It is about 27 K.M. from Gauhati University. The college is located under Hajo revenue circle of Kamrup District.

## ■ Vision and Mission :

The vision of the institution is to inculcate awareness acquiring knowledge and degress among students to become resourceful and developed to the fullest potential. It intends to equip our future generation with the skills necessary for self-reliance and competent citizenship. The mission of the college is to enrich the society through a holistic education for the students.

## ■ Goals and Objectives :

The institution is established with the following distinct goals and objectives :

- a) Dissemination of knowledge of different fields of humanities and modern science.
- b) Comprehensive development of the socio-economic disadvantage and backward people.
- c) To make self improvement and adoption in the modern competitive world.

- d) To uplift a sense of socio responsibility and scientific outlook of the students.

### ■ Rules and Regulations :

1. Classes are held from 9.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
2. Attendance in the classes must be regular and punctual.
3. Students admitted to the college must abide by the rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authority.
4. Students must attend their classes atleast 75% of the total classes held, otherwise they will be treated as NC by the college authority.
5. Students must attend classes and other activities of the college in uniform fixed by the college authority.
6. Students must appear in all the examinations conducted by the college authority.
7. Students must keep their college identity card in the college campus.
8. Students passed higher secondary (Arts/Science) are eligible for admission into T.D.C. course on the basis of merit and according to the college admission rules.



9. Students must comply with the educational decorum inside the college campus.
10. Mobile phone is strictly prohibited within the college campus for the students.
11. The college authority reserves the right to change any rules and regulations when required. The decision of the college authority will be final and binding to all concerned.

■ **College uniform :-**

- a) For boys :- Black Plain Pant, Pink-White stripe, Plain Shirt (full/half), Maroon coloured Sweater.
- b) For girls :- Pink-White stripe Kamiz, White Pant and White Dupatta, Maroon coloured Sweater.

(N.B. - No Jeans Pant or Shirt, Punjabi, Cap any coloured, embroidery in any part of the uniform will be allowed.)

■ **Some Important Instructions :**

- i) Familiarise - yourself with all college rules as notified from time to time.
- ii) Look the notice board daily as soon as you come to and before you leave the college.
- iii) Get cash receipts for all amounts paid in the college office.
- iv) Observe silence and maintain decorum inside the college premises.

- v) Do not move in the corridors and varandah when classes are going on. Any student found loitering around the varandahs without any valid reason will have to face strict disciplinary action.
- vi) Maintain the sanctity of the library with silence and decent and helpful conduct.
- vii) Keep your college clean.
- viii) Chewing betal-nut, taking panmasala, chewin gum etc inside the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- ix) Do not use mobile phone within the college campus.
- x) Do not spit on the walls and in the class room ; don't write or stick anything on the walls, desks and benches. Any one caught red handed will be punished.

#### ■ Student Attendance :

The college takes student's attendance strictly in to account for the purpose of allowing students for appearing at the selection test and filling up of forms for final examination, academic awards and scholarships.

Each student is required to attend a minimum of 75% of the total classes held in each subject respectively in an academic session. If a student fails to attend classes for one month at a stretch from the date of commencement of classes his/her seat is liable to be forfeited. Further, Governing Body will take the decision in its meeting. The parents and guardians will be



issued monthly appraisal/ up dated on their students, works. attendance. If at the end of three month duration their attendance is still insufficient (less than 75%), their admission will stand automatically cancelled.
