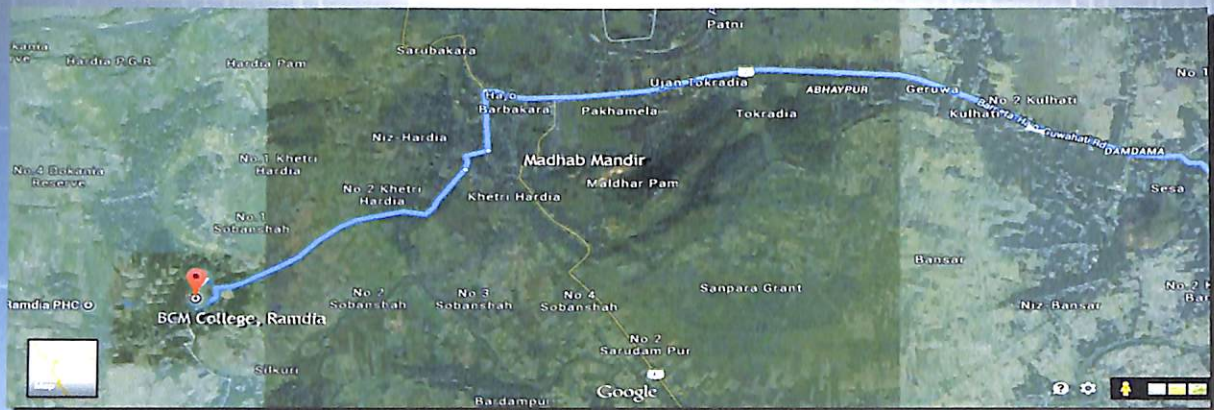
Goals and Objectives

Location of the College

The college is located in the western part of Sri Sri Haygriba Madhab Dewalaya, and Poa Mecca, Hajo. It is about 33 K.M. from Gauhati University. The college is located in Ramdia Mouza under Hajo revenue circle of Kamrup District.

A brief history of B.C.M. College, Ramdia

Binandi Ch. Medhi College, Ramdia (formerly known as Ramdia College) situated at Ramdia, an institution for higher education was established on August 13, 1992.

A group of dedicated persons covering the greater area of Ramdia, Bangalpara, Tokradia, Khetrihardia, Barhardia, Sobancha, Dampur etc. with their relentless and untiring effort has established this institution to provide quality higher education. Later on, the college was renamed as Binandi Chandra Medhi College, Ramdia in the name of the donor Dr. Jyoti Prasad Medhi's father as a gesture of gratitude.

Originally, the college started in "Ramdia Puthibharal Aru Samuhik Sanskritik Kendra" from 13/08/92 and then shifted to its present location on 30-09-1994.

The College attained opening permission on 14-08-1993 and temporarily affiliated to GU in 1995-96. The college also obtained permission for concurrence on 29-12-1999 and obtained the Govt. concurrence up to B.A. part II level on 27-09-2004 and provincialised in 2013, according to the Assam Govt's Venture Institution Provincialisation Act 2011. The college got permanent affiliation from G.U. on 18/12/09 and registered under society Act XXI of 1860 on 12/03/2012. The College is included under 2 (f) and 12 (B) of UGC Act. 1956.

The college gets financial support from No. 1 Ramdia Samabai Samiti, Public donation, Theatrical performance, Lottery and the financial assistance received from the Govt of Assam, before provincialized in 14-08-2013.



Rules and Regulations

- Classes are held from 9.30 a.m. to 4.15 p.m.
- Students admitted to the college must abide by the rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authority.
- Students must attend their classes atleast 75% of the total classes held, otherwise they will be treated as NC by the college authority.
- Students must attend classes and other activities of the college in uniform fixed by the college authority.
- Students must appear in all the examinations conducted by the college authority.
- Students must keep their college identity card in the college campus.
- Students passed higher secondary (Arts/Science) are eligible for admission into T.D.C. course on the basis of merit and according to the college admission rules.
- Students must comply with the educational decorum inside the college campus.
- Mobile phone is strictly prohibited within the college campus for the students.
- The college authority reserves the right to change any rules and regulations when required. The decision of the college authority will be final and binding to all concerned.

Some Important Instructions

- Look the notice board daily as soon as you come to and before you leave the college.
- Get cash receipts for all amounts paid in the college office.
- Do not move in the corridors and varandah when classes are going on. Any student found loitering around the varandahs without any valid reason will have to face strict disciplinary action.
- Keep your college clean.
- Chewing betal-nut, taking panmasala, chewin gum etc inside the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- Do not spit on the walls and in the class room; don't write or stick anything on the walls, desks and benches. Any one caught red handed will be punished.



Student Supportive Services

Personality cum skill development programme

The college gives maximum emphasis on the development of students moral character, discipline, punctuality, accountability, sense of dedication to the society, awareness against illiteracy, superstitions and other social evils.

Students union

The college has the Union Body of the students i.e, “BCMCRSU”. A student who does not have 75% of attendance in the class will not be eligible to be member of Union Body.

Cultural Activities

The college celebrates its Foundation day, Freshman’s social, Saraswati Puja, College week, Teacher’s day in every year as per academic calender.

Yoga Programme

The College has also newly introduced Yoga Programme from the academic session 2014-15 for students for physical and mental development by the expert instructor.

Wall Magazine

The college has a wall magazine “Fehujali” which is the mirror of feeling of students and teachers.

College Magazine

The college has a yearly Magazine i,e. ‘Binandian’ which is the mirror of creative writing and development of both for the student and the teachers.

N.S.S.

The College also has introduced N.S.S. programme under experienced and trained teacher from the Academic Session 2014-15.

Library

The college has a well compact library with a collection of large number of books, journals, newspapers, magazines for the benefit of the students and the teachers as well as employees. It also provides the quiet and safe reading place in the library for the students.



Sports facilities

The college has indoor and outdoor sports facilities and equipments for different sports like football, volleyball, badminton, carrom, cricket etc.

Scholarship

Scholarship for the poor meritorious students also provided as per Govt. Norms.

Free Education

A number of poor students are given free education on the basis of merit, approved by the Admission Committee.

Special Coaching

Special coaching is also provided to needy students.

Other Programmes

The college organizes seminars, debate, quiz, students election, essay writing competition etc. in every year. Besides the college also organizes several sensitization programmes on health and hygiene, poverty alleviation programme and preservation of the environment etc.

Student Attendance

The college takes student's attendance strictly in to account for the purpose of allowing students for appearing at the selection test and filling up of forms for final examination, academic awards and scholarships.

Each student is required to attend a minimum of 75% of the total classes held in each subject respectively in an academic session. If a student fails to attend classes for one month at a stretch from the date of commencement of classes his/her seat is liable to be forfeited. Further, Governing Body will take the decision in its meeting. The parents and guardians will be issued monthly appraisal /up dated report of the students, works, attendance. If at the end of three month duration their attendance is still insufficient (less than 75%), their admission will stand automatically cancelled.

College uniform

For boys :- Black Plain Pant, Pink-White stripe, Plain Shirt (full/half), Maroon coloured Sweater.

For girls :- Pink-White stripe Kamiz, White Pant and White Dupatta, Maroon coloured Sweater.

N.B. - No Jeans Pant or Shirt, Punjabi, Cap (any coloured), embroidery in any part of the uniform will be allowed.



Admission procedure

- a) The college advertises about the dates of admission to various classes through the college notice board.
- b) Students seeking admission into their respective classes should apply in prescribed form, which may be collected along with prospectus from the college office during office hours.
- c) Candidates are required to produce original copies of the following documents at the time of admission for verification :
- Marksheet of the last qualifying examination.
 - Admit card of H.S.L.C./H.S.
 - Registration Certificate
 - Certificate from the Head of the institution - last attended.
 - Gap certificate if necessary
 - Certificate of proficiency in co-curricular activities.
 - Caste certificate where necessary.
- d) Admission into major course will be on the basis of marks secured on the said subject with the approval of the HOD concerned.

Key points of Semester System

1. A student will get maximum three chances to clear a particular semester. Three chances means, three continuous examinations of a particular semester irrespective of a student appear or not. For example, a student of 2014 batch will get three chances i.e. in 2014, 2015 and 2016, thus, the student shall have to complete his/her all papers of 1st semester Examination on or before 2016.
2. Students can apply for repeat examination in one of the theory papers in 1st, 2nd and 3rd semester examinations. The provision for repeat examination is not applicable for 4th, 5th and 6th semester examinations.
3. Re evaluation of answer scripts should be addressed to the Deputy Controller of Examination, GU through the principal within 15 days from the date of declaration of results of the respective examination.
4. Students passing in any paper(s) in a semester need to appear in the remaining papers (Failed or not appeared) in the next examination. Students passing in practical paper(s) of a subject need to appear only in theory paper(s) in the subsequent examination.
5. It is mandatory for all the students to appear in Sessional Examinations. The minimum mark for passing in each paper is 30% of total marks.

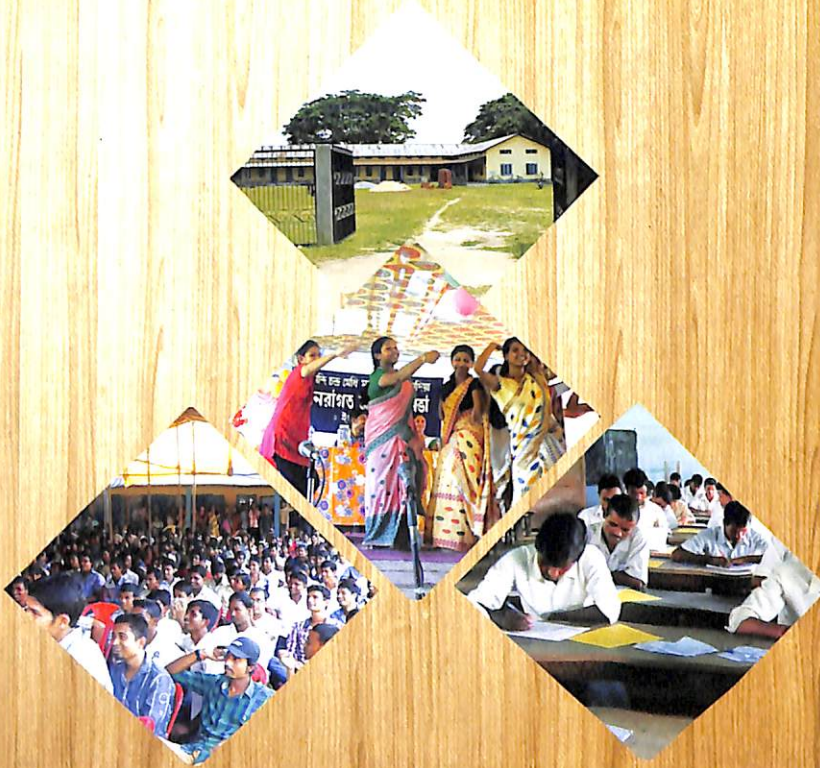
